## Black Sea

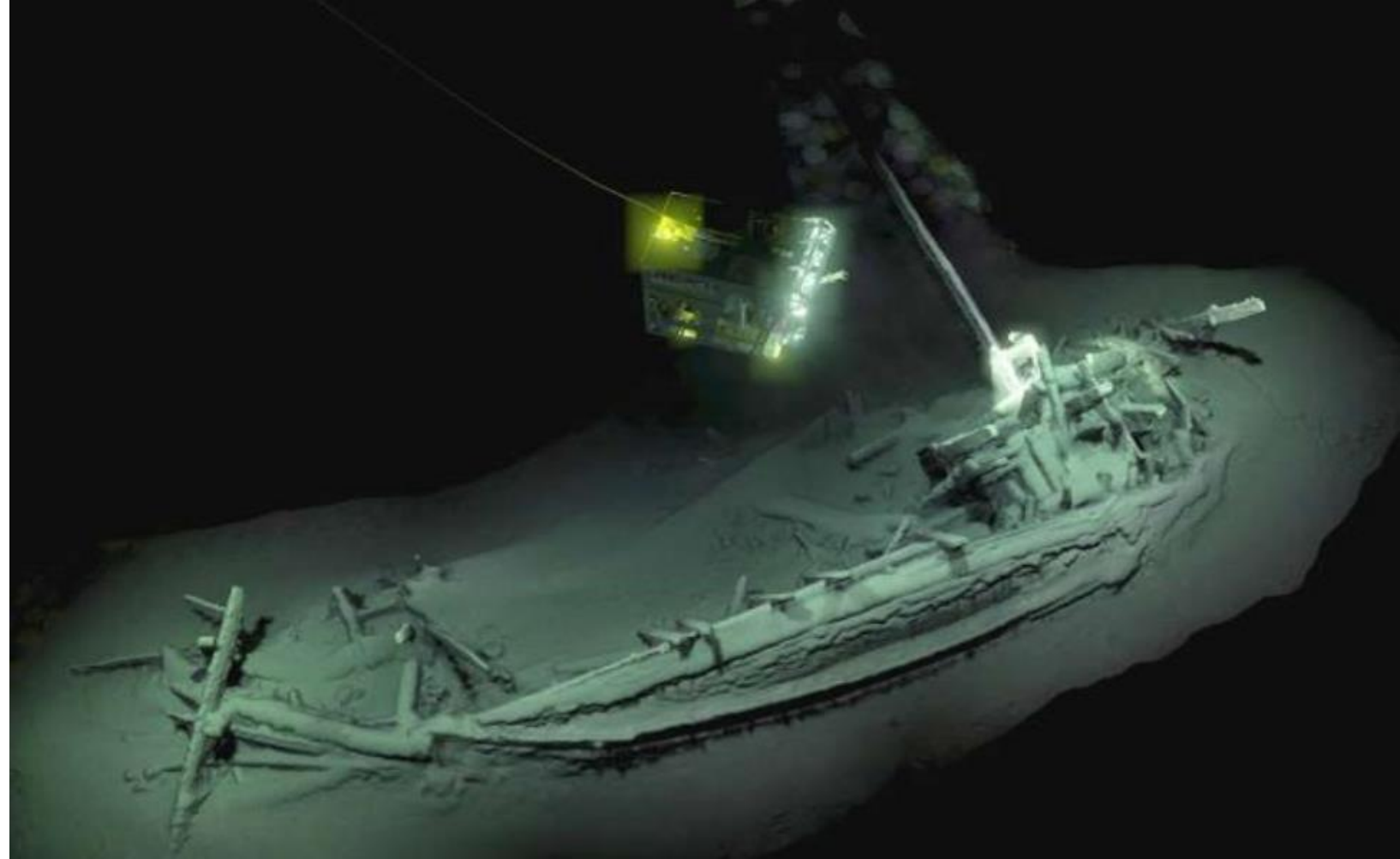
- The **Black Sea** is a marginal Mediterranean sea of the Atlantic Ocean lying between Europe and Asia. It is bounded by Bulgaria, Georgia, Romania, Russia, Turkey, and Ukraine. It is supplied by major rivers, principally the Danube, Dnieper, Dniester, and Don. Its drainage basin includes parts of 24 countries in Europe.
- The International Day of the Black Sea is **October 31**.
- Popular supposition derives "**Black Sea**" from the **dark color of the water or climatic conditions**.

## NO LIFE IN THE BLACK SEA

- The Black Sea has 2 layers of water - with oxygen (100 m.) and with hydrogen sulfide (100-2000 m.). It is a constant state of the sea.
- This is the reason why the remains of many ships have been preserved at the bottom. In 2018, archeologists discovered the oldest processed wood boat in the world. It was made 2400 years ago.
- There are more than 60 ships around it.

# SHORT HISTORY

## Burgas

The earliest signs of life in the region date back 3000 years, to the Bronze Age.

Burgas [bur'gas] is in the region of Northern Thrace. It is suggested that the name of the city ultimately comes from the name of khan Burtaz (683-633 BC). There is also explanation that it is derived from the Latin word "burgus" (like a town Burgos in Spain) and from the German word "burg" as meaning a "tower" (it is according to a table from 154 – 155, found in Bulgaria).





The city of **Burgas** is surrounded by lakes presented on a map in 1697 as Pergas.

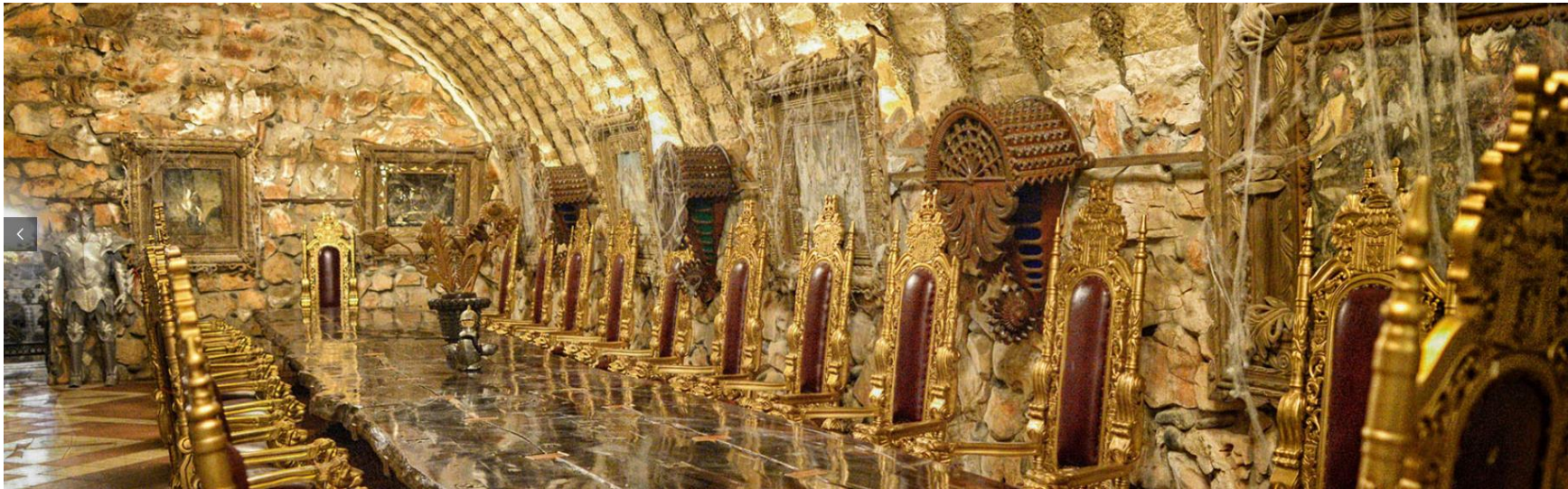
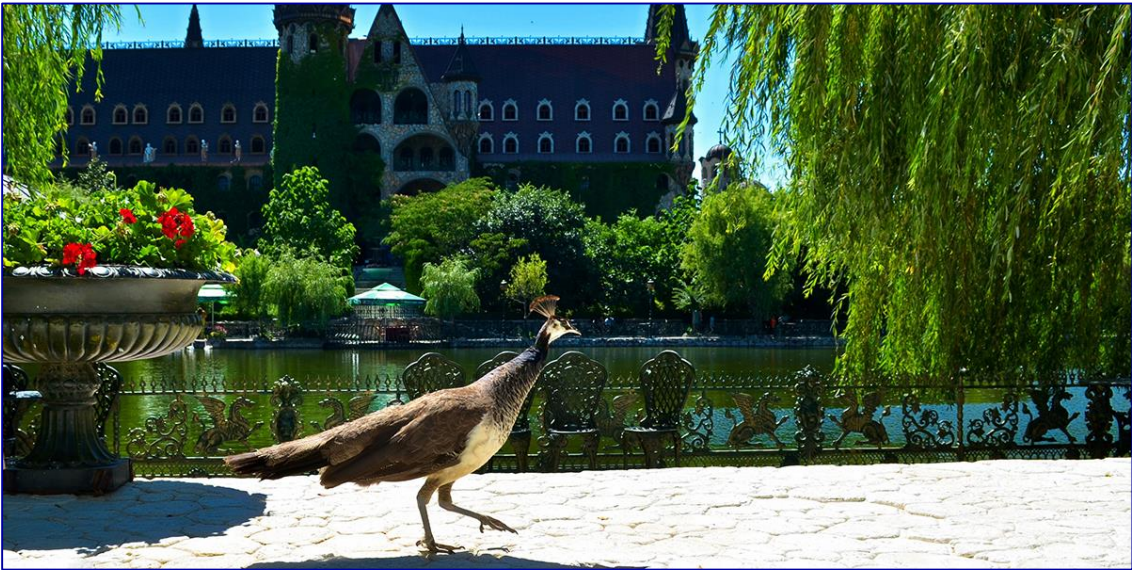
