SI Club Ruse for Ukraine

Since the beginning of the war, we have

- raised 700 Euro;
- supplied non-perishable food, tea, coffee and other goods (cell phone chargers), by request from the Red Cross for the two entry posts in Ruse – the Border Post at the Danube Bridge and the Central Railway Station March-April 2022.

Since the beginning of the war, we have

- supplied bedding (sheets, pillows, pillowcases) for the Red Cross and the Crisis Centre Caritas, where Ukrainian families are staying – for 20 people – March – April, 2022 ;

Since the beginning of the war, we have

-volunteered at the two entry posts -the Central Railway Station and the border checkpoints at the Danube bridge;

– we volunteered **140** hours in March - May 2022.



SI Club Ruse for Ukraine

Since the beginning of the war, we have

actively supported the Shevtsov family and their relatives by

- providing free lesson in Bulgarian language to their children who all attend Bulgarian school (4 kids altogether);
- buying winter shoes for of them (10 people altogether) – 10.2022;
- Paying part of their rent after they were forced to leave the Caritas Crisis Centre – 12.2022;
- Providing sheets, pillows, household appliances and utensils for their new place 11-12.2022
