- *highest bell-tower in the world*
- *largeste lutheran church in Germany*
- *built and financed by the citizens of Ulm*



The Fisher's District



- *majority of buildings preserved*
- *most buildings are from the 15th to 17th century*
- *was populated by fishers, rivermen and tanners*
- *it's idyllic and ideal for a calming walk*



Ulm Town Hall

- *originally an exchange*
- *upper floor has long been used as a chamber for the city administration*



Central Library

- *built after the design of Gottfried Böhm*
- *located in the middle of Ulm*
- *accessible to everyone during opening hours*



The Danube

- *divides Ulm and Neu/New-Ulm*
- *Old city walls and promenades are perfect for walks*

Oath House

- *built in the 17th century*
- *the mayor of Ulm annually gives account to the people of Ulm from the balcony of the building*
- *serves as historical archive*
