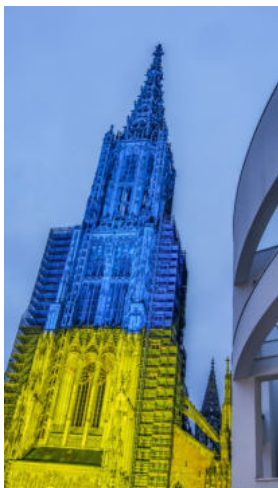


The Danube-Networkers invite to the 83th international session by
